

Commencement of WTG Installation works at Gwynt y Mor Duration: Commencing 26th June 2013 until further notice

Please be advised that Wind Turbine Generator [WTG] further installation works will commence on the 26th June 2013. The Turbine installation vessel Sea Worker will be on site from the 26th June 2013. The Sea Worker will be towed out of Mostyn to the Gwynt y Mor offshore wind farm site on a regular basis, the tugs involved with the Sea Worker will be the Sea Echo and the Sea Bravo .These vessel's will be conducting operations within the Gwynt y Mor offshore wind farm site at various locations, and when on location will require a 500m clearance at all times. In addition to the vessel being on location within the GyM site, the support vessels will pre install an "anchor pattern" at the next scheduled location for the vessel. The coordinates for the anchor pattern will be forwarded to all project vessels as soon as they are known. During transit to/from the port of Mostyn the vessel should receive the appropriate clearance for a Tug and tow. The vessel will monitor VHF CH 16 at all times.



Admiralty Chart Layout of Gwynt y Mor including Export Cable Routes




